The Definite Article

The definite article *the* is used:

- To refer to something we've already mentioned or has already been specified
- 2. When it's assumed there's only one of something
- 3. Before superlatives and ordinal numbers
- 4. Before names of monuments or geographic features (oceans, rivers, deserts, etc.)

Examples:

I came here by taxi. <u>The</u> driver was very talkative. (We know it's the driver of my cab.)

<u>The</u> sunset was beautiful yesterday.

My house is the second one from the left.

The Great Wall of China can be seen from space.

The Indefinite Article

The indefinite article **a/an** is used:

- 1. When the identity of a singular noun is not known or not important
- 2. To show that a noun is part of a group.
- 3. To tell someone's profession

Use "an" when the next word begins with a vowel or silent "h". Use "a" when the next word begins with a consonant.

There's a red bump where a mosquito bit me.

I'm an American citizen.

He's a doctor. She's an actress.

You're <u>an</u> **author**. You wrote this book in <u>an</u> **hour**.

You're a successful author.
