adjetivo + sustantivo...

Sustantivo + (to be) + adjetivo.

Reglas Generales

1. Los adjetivos se ponen directamente antes de un sustantivo para describir o especificar de cuál hablas.
2. También se puede poner un adjetivo después de una conjugación de "to be".
3. Los adjetivos en inglés son invariables, lo que quiere decir que no cambian de forma (no importa si el sustantivo es singular o plural).

Ejemplos:

*The **short blonde** **girl** is my sister.*

*You have **beautiful blue** **eyes**.*

*My **grandpa** **is old**.*

*We **are happy** because it's Friday.*

*My **dad** **is tall**. My **brothers** are **tall**, too.*
