Natural Things

1. **Grass** (*pasto, grama*)
The grass is always greener on the other side. (*El pasto siempre es más verde del otro lado.*)
2. **Tree** (*árbol*)
Trees give us the oxygen we breathe. (*Los árboles nos dan el oxígeno que respiramos.*)
3. **Dirt** (*tierra, suciedad, mugre*)
Dirt can stain your clothes. (*La suciedad puede manchar tu ropa.*)
4. **Mud** (*barro*)
Mud is basically wet dirt. (*El barro es básicamente tierra húmeda.*)
5. **Fresh air** (*aire fresco*)
Breathe in that fresh air! (*¡Respira ese aire fresco!*)

6. **Slide** (*tobogán*)
Slide down the slide; don't climb up! (*Deslízate por el tobogán; ¡no subas!*)
7. **Swings** (*columpios*)
I like to swing high on the swings. (*Me gusta balancear alto en los columpios.*)
8. **Monkey bars** (*barras*)
The monkey bars give me callouses. (*Las barras de mono me dan callos.*)

9. **Garbage can** (*basurero*)
Throw out your trash in the garbage can. (*Tira tu basura en el basurero.*)
10. **Bench** (*banco*)
Can we sit down on the bench for a minute? (*¿Podemos sentarnos en el banco un minuto?*)
11. **Lamp post / Light post** (*farol, farola*)
The lamp post gives us light at night. (*El poste de luz nos ilumina de noche.*)
12. **Picnic table** (*mesa de picnic*)
Let's eat lunch at that picnic table. (*Almorcemos en esa mesa de picnic.*)
13. **Drinking fountain** (*bebedero, fuente de agua*)
I need some water from the drinking fountain. (*Necesito agua del bebedero.*)
14. **Walking path** (*camino para caminar*)
Are bikes allowed on the walking path? (*¿Se permiten bicicletas en el camino para caminar?*)
