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## Repaso de la forma positiva

**To Talk (positiva)**

Singular			Plural		
I	talk		we	talk	
you	talk		you	talk	
he/she it	talks		they	talk	

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## Ejemplo de "to talk"

**To Talk (negativa)**

Singular			Plural		
I	do not	talk	we	do not	talk
you	do not	talk	you	do not	talk
he/she it	does not	talk	they	do not	talk

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### Forma de contracción

► Las formas acortadas son mas comunes en el habla cotidiana

- **do not** se acorta a **don't**
  - You do not make me mad. → You don't make me mad.
- **does not** se acorta a **doesn't**
  - He does not understand. → He doesn't understand.

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### Ejemplo con contracciones

**To Talk (negativa con contracción)**

Singular			Plural		
I	don't	talk	we	don't	talk
you	don't	talk	you	don't	talk
he/she it	doesn't	talk	they	don't	talk

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### Formas positiva y negativa

Positivo	Negativo	Negativo (contracción)
1. I talk	1. I do not talk	1. I don't talk
2. you talk	2. you do not talk	2. you don't talk
3. he talk <u>s</u>	3. he <b>does</b> not talk	3. he <b>doesn't</b> talk
4. she talk <u>s</u>	4. she <b>does</b> not talk	4. she <b>doesn't</b> talk
5. it talk <u>s</u>	5. it <b>does</b> not talk	5. it <b>doesn't</b> talk
6. we talk	6. we do not talk	6. we don't talk
7. they talk	7. they do not talk	7. they don't talk

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### Errores comunes

- ✓ I run every day. *(positiva)*
- ✓ I do not run every day. *(negativa)*
- ✗ I not run every day.
- ✗ I no run every day.
- ✗ I does not run.
- ✗ I do not runs every day.

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### Errores comunes

- ✓ Oliver travels a lot. *(positiva)*
- ✓ Oliver does not travel a lot. *(negativa)*
- ✗ Oliver does not travels a lot.
- ✗ Oliver not travel a lot.

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### Recuerda

- ▶ Casi todos los pronombres usan "do not" entre el sujeto y la base verbal
  - ▶ Solo la 3ª singular usa "does not"
- ▶ Todo pronombre de sujeto usa la base verbal
- ▶ Las contracciones (*don't* y *doesn't*) son más comunes en el habla cotidiana
