### La Forma Negativa

Singular

Plural

I	do not	<b>verbo</b>
you	do not	<b>verbo</b>
he/ she/ it	<b>does not</b>	<b>verbo</b>

we	do not	<b>verbo</b>
you	do not	<b>verbo</b>
they	do not	<b>verbo</b>

do not → **don't**  
does not → **doesn't**

#### To talk

I do not talk	we do not talk
you do not talk	you do not talk
(s)he <b>does not</b> talk	they do not talk



#### To talk

I <b>don't</b> talk	we <b>don't</b> talk
you <b>don't</b> talk	you <b>don't</b> talk
(s)he <b>doesn't</b> talk	they <b>don't</b> talk

### Reglas Generales

- Para hacer la forma negativa, añade "do not" entre el sujeto y el verbo (la base verbal).
- Para la tercera persona:
  - Añade "does not" entre el sujeto y el verbo
  - Fíjate que el **verbo principal** en todas las personas **es siempre igual**. La única cosa que cambia es "do/ does".
- "Do not" se puede acortar a "**don't**"; "does not" se acorta a "**doesn't**".

### Ejemplos:

We like baseball. **We do not like** soccer.

He likes sushi. **He does not like** tacos.

He reads magazines, but he doesn't read books.

She studies French. She doesn't study Japanese.

I do not like you. → I don't like you.

He does not laugh much. → He doesn't laugh much.
